April 23, 2003

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a special meeting of the City Council of the City of Rapid City was held at the City/School Administration Center in Rapid City, South Dakota on Wednesday, April 23, 2003 at 2:45 P.M.

Mayor Jerry Munson, Finance Officer Jim Preston, and the following Alderpersons were present: Tom Murphy, Martha Rodriguez, Ron Kroeger, Bill Waugh, Tom Johnson, Sam Kooiker and Ray Hadley; the following arrived during the course of the meeting: None; and the following were absent: Mel Dreyer, Rick Kriebel and Alan Hanks.

The following Resolution was introduced, read and Johnson moved its adoption:

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION CANVASSING VOTE FOR THE  
MUNICIPAL SECONDARY ELECTION HELD APRIL 22, 2003

WHEREAS there was held in the City of Rapid City, South Dakota, on Tuesday, the 8th day of April, 2003, the Annual Municipal Election of the City of Rapid City, South Dakota, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and five Alderpersons of said City; and

WHEREAS at said election no candidate for Mayor received a majority of the votes cast for that office; and

WHEREAS a secondary election was called for the purpose of electing a Mayor between the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes cast for that office in the Annual Municipal Election; and

WHEREAS there was held in the City of Rapid City, South Dakota, on Tuesday, the 22nd day of April, 2003, a Secondary Municipal Election for the purpose of electing a Mayor of said City; and

WHEREAS at said election the total number of votes cast for the office of Mayor were as follows:
