June 21, 2004

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a special meeting of the City Council of the City of Rapid City was held at the City/School Administration Center in Rapid City, South Dakota on Monday, June 21, 2004 at 6:55 P.M.

Mayor Jim Shaw and the following Alderpersons were present: Alan Hanks, Jean French, Sam Kooiker, Tom Murphy, Martha Rodriguez, Bill Waugh, Ray Hadley, Ron Kroeger, Rick Kriebel and Jeff Partridge. The following Alderpersons arrived during the course of the meeting: None; and the following were absent: None.

The following Resolution was introduced, read and Waugh moved is adoption:

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION CANVASSING VOTE FOR THE
MUNICIPAL SECONDARY ELECTION HELD JUNE 15, 2004

WHEREAS there was held in the City of Rapid City, South Dakota, on Tuesday, the 1st day of June, 2004, the Annual Municipal Election of the City of Rapid City, South Dakota, for the purpose of electing five Alderpersons of said City; and

WHEREAS at said election no candidate for Fourth Ward Alderman and Fifth Ward Alderman received a majority of the votes cast for that office; and

WHEREAS a secondary election was called for the purpose of electing an Alderman from the Fourth Ward and from the Fifth Ward between the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes cast for those respective offices in the Annual Municipal Election; and

WHEREAS there was held in the City of Rapid City, South Dakota, on Tuesday, the 15th day of June, 2004, a Secondary Municipal Election for the purpose of electing an Alderman from the Fourth Ward and the Fifth Ward of said City; and

WHEREAS at said election the total number of votes cast for the office of Alderman from the Fourth Ward were as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Rapid City, that Ray Hadley having received a majority of all votes cast for the office of Alderman for the Fourth Ward, for a term of two years, is hereby declared to be duly elected to the office of Alderman of the City of Rapid City for the term as hereinabove set forth, and is entitled to qualify for and hold said office as provided by law; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Rapid City, that Malcom Chapman having received a majority of all votes cast for the office of Alderman for the Fifth Ward, for a term of two years, is hereby declared to be duly elected to the office of Alderman of the City of Rapid City for the term as hereinabove set forth, and is entitled to qualify for and hold said office as provided by law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is found and determined to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and for the support of the municipal government and its existing public institutions, wherefor an emergency exists and this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.
