Rapid City, South Dakota

June 7, 2004

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a special meeting of the City Council of the City of Rapid City was held at the City/School Administration Center in Rapid City, South Dakota on Monday, June 7, 2004 at 6:30 P.M.

Mayor Jim Shaw and the following Alderpersons were present: Jean French, Alan Hanks, Sam Kooiker, Tom Murphy, Bill Waugh, Martha Rodriguez, Ron Kroeger and Ray Hadley. The following arrived during the course of the meeting: None; and the following were absent: Jeff Partridge and Rick Kriebel.

The following Resolution was introduced, read and Waugh moved its adoption:

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION CANVASSING VOTE  
FOR THE ANNUAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION  
HELD JUNE 1, 2004

WHEREAS there was held in the City of Rapid City, South Dakota, on Tuesday, the 1st day of June, 2004, the Annual Municipal Election of the City of Rapid City, South Dakota, for the purpose of electing five Alderpersons of said City; and

WHEREAS at said election the total number of votes cast for the office of Alderman were as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Rapid City, as follows:

1. Tom Johnson having received a majority of all votes cast for the office of Alderman for the First Ward, for a term of two years, is hereby declared to be duly elected to the office of Alderman of the City of Rapid City for the First Ward and for the term as hereinabove set forth, and is entitled to qualify for and hold said office as provided by law.

2. Sam Kooiker having been unopposed as candidate for the office of Alderman for the Second Ward, for a term of two years, is hereby declared to be duly elected to the office of Alderman of the City of Rapid City for the Second Ward, and for the term as hereinabove set forth, and is entitled to qualify for and hold said office as provided by law.

3. Karen Olson having received a majority of all votes cast for the office of Alderman for the Third Ward, for a term of two years, is hereby declared to be duly elected to the office of Alderman of the City of Rapid City for the Second Ward and for the term as hereinabove set forth, and is entitled to qualify for and hold said office as provided by law.

4. Ray Hadley and Jim Hansen, candidates for Alderman, Ward Four, being the two candidates who received the highest number of votes cast for said office but who failed to receive a majority of all votes cast therefore, are hereby declared to be candidates for said office at a secondary election to be held on Tuesday, June 15, 2004, such secondary election to be held at the same polling places, with the same judges and clerks, and shall be conducted, returned, and canvassed and the result declared and entered on the journal of the City in the same manner as the first election.

5. Malcom Chapman and Mel Dreyer, candidates for Alderman, Ward Five, being the two candidates who received the highest number of votes cast for said office but who failed to receive a majority of all votes cast therefore, are hereby declared to be candidates for said office at a secondary election to be held on Tuesday, June 15, 2004, such secondary election to be held at the same polling places, with the same judges and clerks, and shall be conducted, returned, and canvassed and the result declared and entered on the journal of the City in the same manner as the first election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is found and determined to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and for the support of the municipal government and its existing public institutions, wherefore an emergency exists and this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.
