

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE CITY COUNCIL
Rapid City, South Dakota
June 22, 2005

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a special meeting of the City Council of the City of Rapid City was held at the City/School Administration Center in Rapid City, South Dakota on Wednesday, June 22, 2005 at 6:50 P.M.

The following members were present: Alderpersons Ray Hadley, Malcom Chapman, Tom Murphy, Ron Kroeger, Tom Johnson, Karen Olson, Sam Kooiker, Bob Hurlbut and Bill Waugh. The following Alderperson arrived during the course of the meeting: None; and the following were absent: Jean French.

Staff members present included Finance Officer Jim Preston and Administrative Assistant Jackie Gerry.

The following Resolution was introduced, read and Johnson moved its adoption:

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION CANVASSING VOTE
FOR THE MUNICIPAL SECONDARY ELECTION
HELD JUNE 21, 2005

WHEREAS there was held in the City of Rapid City, South Dakota, on Tuesday, the 7th day of June, 2005, the Annual Municipal Election of the City of Rapid City, South Dakota, for the purpose of electing five Alderpersons of said City and a Mayor; and

WHEREAS at said election no candidate for First Ward Alderman received a majority of the votes cast for that office; and

WHEREAS a secondary election was called for the purpose of electing an Alderman from the First Ward between the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes cast for those respective offices in the Annual Municipal Election; and

WHEREAS there was held in the City of Rapid City, South Dakota, on Tuesday, the 21st day of June, 2005, a Secondary Municipal Election for the purpose of electing an Alderman from the First Ward of said City; and

WHEREAS at said election the total number of votes cast for the office of Alderman from the First Ward were as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Rapid City, that Michael Schumacher having received a majority of all votes cast for the office of Alderman for the First Ward, for a term of two years, is hereby declared to be duly elected to the office of Alderman of the City of Rapid City for the term as hereinabove set forth, and is entitled to qualify for and hold said office as provided by law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is found and determined to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and for the support of the

municipal government and its existing public institutions, wherefor an emergency exists and this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.
