

PROCEEDINGS OF THE CITY COUNCIL
Rapid City, South Dakota

June 28, 2007

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a special meeting of the City Council of the City of Rapid City was held at the City/School Administration Center in Rapid City, South Dakota on Thursday, June 28, 2007 at 12:30 P.M.

The following members were present: Mayor Jim Shaw and the following Alderpersons: Ron Kroeger, Malcom Chapman, Tom Johnson, Lloyd LaCroix, Bill Okrepkie, and Deb Hadcock; and the following Alderpersons arrived during the course of the meeting: None; and the following were absent: Mike Schumacher, Karen Olson, Sam Kooiker, and Bob Hurlbut.

Staff members present included Assistant Finance Officer Coleen Schmidt, City Attorney Jason Green, and Administrative Coordinator Jackie Gerry.

The Chair indicated this was the time to canvas the Municipal Secondary Election held June 26, 2007.

The following Resolution was introduced, read and Okrepkie moved its adoption:

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION CANVASSING VOTE FOR THE
MUNICIPAL SECONDARY ELECTION HELD JUNE 26, 2007

WHEREAS there was held in the City of Rapid City, South Dakota, on Tuesday, the 5th day of June, 2007, the Annual Election of the City of Rapid City, South Dakota, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and four Alderpersons of said City; and

WHEREAS at said election no candidate for Mayor received a majority of the votes cast for that office; and

WHEREAS at said election no candidate for First Ward Alderman received a majority of the votes cast for that office; and

WHEREAS at said election no candidate for Fourth Ward Alderman received a majority of the votes cast for that office; and

WHEREAS a secondary election was called for the purpose of electing a Mayor and an Alderman for the First Ward and an Alderman for the Fourth Ward between the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes cast for those respective offices in the Annual Municipal Election; and

WHEREAS there was held in the City of Rapid City, South Dakota, on Tuesday, the 26th day of June, 2007, a Secondary Municipal Election for the purpose of electing a Mayor and an Alderman from the First Ward and an Alderman from the Fourth Ward of said City; and

WHEREAS at said election the total number of votes cast for the office of Mayor and Alderman were as follows:

Alan Hanks having received a majority of all votes cast for the office of Mayor for a term of two years, is hereby declared to be duly elected to the office of Mayor of the City of Rapid City for the term as hereinabove set forth, and is entitled to qualify for and hold said office as provided by law; and
2. Ron Weifenbach having received a majority of all votes cast for the office of Alderman for the First Ward, for a term of two years, is hereby declared to be duly elected to the office of Alderman of the City of Rapid City for the term as hereinabove set forth, and is entitled to qualify for and hold said office as provided by law; and
3. Ron Kroeger having received a majority of all votes cast for the office of Alderman for the Fourth Ward, for a term of two years, is hereby declared to be duly elected to the office of Alderman of the City of Rapid City for the term as hereinabove set forth, and is entitled to qualify for and hold said office as provided by law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is found and determined to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and for the support of the municipal government and its existing public institutions, wherefor an emergency exists and this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.
